

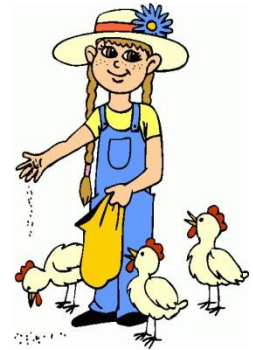
Kindergarten Excursion to Calmsley Hill City Farm

Dear Parents and Carers

To support our Science unit 'Paddock to Plate' Kindergarten will be going on an excursion to Calmsley Hill City Farm on **Friday 26 May 2017**. This special program focuses on how farms work, what is produced on a farm and how farm animals and plants provide for people's needs. Students will be participating in a range of activities including milking a cow, patting animals and watching farm demonstrations. We will be travelling by bus (a coach with seat belts) **leaving promptly at 9:05 am** and will return before 3:00 pm.
