Term 2 Recreational and School Sport Options

Dear Parents and Carers

The Recreational and School Sport Program will run for nine weeks in Term 2, commencing in Week 2, on Friday 5 May and finishing in Week 10, on Friday 30 June. The activities that are outlined below will depend on interest and the availability of bookings. Students will still have the option to participate in school-based sport if they wish.

These prices are based on the maximum and/or estimated number of students participating. If there are less, then the price will rise due to the bus costs. **Please note that if the minimum number of participants needed for each sport is not reached, the activity will not be able to proceed.**

There have been a number of recent instances where students have chosen to participate in recreational sports and have subsequently changed their mind or have pulled out. This significantly affects school sporting budgets as well as staff supervision ratios. It is expected that students who select a recreational sport will commit to and **pay** for that chosen sport.

Children who were selected for PSSA winter sport (AFL, netball or soccer) in Terms 2 and 3 are not eligible for any of these options.

Please complete the form attached and return it to the sports box in the office no later than 4.00 pm Thursday 6 April 2017. Unfortunately late applications will not be accepted. A confirmation note will go home in Week 1 of Term 2 requesting payment and permission to attend the chosen sporting activity. Permission is required before students are able to participate in recreational sport commencing in Week 2.
