### School Swimming Carnivals

Dear Parents and Carers

The swimming carnivals for students aged 8 years and over will be held during Week 3 at school. All students are encouraged to participate and enjoy the day of swimming.

This year, students will need to select the events they wish to enter **prior** to the carnival as we are trialling 'Meet Manager', a computer based recording system. Students will not be able to change their mind on the day as it may disrupt the running of the carnival. Please see the program on the back for the events students may want to enter.

**Senior Carnival (Years 5 and 6): Wednesday, 14 February 2018**

**Junior Carnival (Years 3 and 4): Thursday, 15 February 2018**

On the day students should:

- bring, **including cap (compulsory)**, goggles;
- dress in sports uniform;
- bring sunscreen;
- wear a hat;
- bring lunch or order from the canteen; and
- bring a bottle of water.

The **fastest five times** for each age will contest the finals on the following Wednesday evening, 21 February 2018.

This year we will be offering a **non-competitive 25m freestyle** swim for any Years 3-6 students who does not wish to contest the 50m freestyle and/or stroke events. This is not available to Year 2 students. Students may not enter both the competitive and non-competitive events.

The Canteen will be open for parents who attend the carnivals and will sell tea, coffee and general canteen food.
